

THE STORY

When Christopher Columbus came to the New World, he was one of the first Westerners to discover tobacco. The local Indians showed him how to smoke tobacco leaves, and Columbus and his lieutenants quickly adopted the custom. When the idea came home, smoking became quite popular in Spain and Portugal. The French ambassador to Portugal, Jean Nicot, spread cigar smoking in France and nicotine got its name. It was at this time that manufacturers in Spain began to wrap dried tobacco in paper rather than sheets. After that, many companies started growing mass-produced tobacco and cigars. Cuba has become a very popular place for growing tobacco plants due to its fertile soil and warm climate. A Cuban tobacco industry was soon established, and sailboats distribute tobacco grown in Cuba from Europe to Asia. Columbus claimed Cuba for Spain and during this period the Spaniards dominated the tobacco industry. They even set a monopoly on the crop that lasted until 1817, forbidding Cuban growers from selling it to anyone but themselves.
